(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to pedestrians and cyclists where applicable the lengths of footpaths specified in Schedules of this notice.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Bristol Water for investigation works, trial holes and installation of potable water pipework for a maximum period of six months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be in two phases. **Phase 1** to become operative on **27 June 2017** anticipated to be **four weeks** in duration. **Phase 2** to become operative in **early September 2017** anticipated to be **eight to ten weeks** in duration.
