

MILLENNIUM GREEN TRUST

The small field on the south side of the River Yeo is part of the Millennium Green.

When it was first established in 2000 a small Orchard was planted with a number of fruit trees including ‘The Congresbury Beauty Apple’. The trees are pruned and cared for by a group of volunteers.

The field was grazed by a local Farmer, but there were issues with dogs worrying the sheep and it was decided that it should become part of North Somerset’s ‘Rewilding Project’. This is an ambitious scheme to help meet our commitment to combat Global warming.



In March 2020 a number of trees were planted but due to the prolonged drought in April and May many have failed to become established. It is hoped that they will be replaced in 2021 and further planting undertaken.

The Millennium Green Trust would like to invite anyone who has time to assist with both the tree planting and routine grass cutting. Small working parties will be arranged when circumstances and Government guidance permit.
