

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - Section 14
Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order
Puxton Lane, Hewish North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2022
Date coming Into Force: 16th January 2022

Final Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. **Exemptions** are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to undertake Fibre Cabling & jointing. This will become operative on the 16th January 2022 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is **anticipated to be of 2 days in duration**, across two phases (16/01/2022 & 23/01/2022). Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule

16/01/2022 - Puxton Lane - Southwards from junction with Bristol Road to junction with Puxton Road

23/01/2022 - Puxton Lane - Southwards from junction with Puxton Road for roughly 150m
