

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - Section 14(1)
Final Notice (3a) of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order
Footpaths AX16/2, AX16/3 & AX16/27 Congresbury North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Pedestrians Order 2024

Ref: SW23.24-316

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to pedestrians the lengths of footpaths specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of footpath.

This order came into force on 11th March 2024 for a maximum period of six months and was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Bridge Civil Engineering for the Environment Agency for repairs to river bank, revetments & footbridge. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to re-commence 12 August 2024 and be of approximately 3 weeks in duration. Appropriate pedestrian traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Near Congresbury Weir Footpaths & Footbridge closure **Footpath AX16/2** parts AX16/2/10 & AX16/2/20. **Footpath AX16/3** parts AX16/3/10 & AX16/3/20 and **Footpath AX16/27** part AX16/27/10 for its full extent
