Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order
Footpaths AX16/2/10 Congresbury North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Pedestrians Order 2024
Date coming Into Force: 22 July 2024

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to pedestrians the lengths of footpath specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of footpath.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Kier Group plc for the Environment Agency for earthworks to river bank berm. This will become operative on the **22 July 2024** for a maximum period of six months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of at least 6 months in duration. Appropriate pedestrian traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.
