CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMPS & RAISED TABLES,
BRINSEA ROAD, CONGRESBURY

The introduction of a raised table to the existing pedestrian crossing North of Stonewell Lane on Brinsea Road in Congresbury is intended to create a safer road crossing for those vulnerable road users using Brinsea Road.

The introduction of speed cushions on Brinsea Road will assist in maintaining suitable vehicle speeds in accordance with the 20mph speed limit.

These works are intended so as to avoid danger to persons or traffic using the road, or any other road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, they will help to facilitate the passage on the road of pedestrians and cyclists. They should help to preserve the character of the road.
