A resident of Brinsea Road spoke of his objections to the solar farm, these included that the site is too big and will impact on the farming, ecology and diversity and the Strawberry Line which is a nature reserve. The access is on to an already busy road where the visibility is not good. There will be disruption caused by the construction of the site and connecting the necessary cables along a busy road. The site boundary appears to be on his driveway and the whole area is prone to flooding. If raised areas are required this may make the flooding worse.

The alternative suggestion is not suitable for bats and swallows as they like to roost and nest high up.

c) <u>25/P/0714/AOC</u> - 101 Brinsea Road Congresbury BS49 5JL - request to discharge conditions 3 (Surface water drainage and implementation), 5 (Ecological assessment and mitigation), 6 (biodiversity value), 7 (Details and location of lighting), 8 (Landscaping scheme), 11 (Location of signs prohibiting access for larger vehicles) and 13 (Storage and collection of waste and recycling) on application 24/P/0442/FUL.
